If you Gift Aid your donation, the charity will continue to receive an additional 28p. Charities can claim Gift Aid tax relief of 25p on every pound you give. HMRC will also be operating transitional provisions for Gift Aid donations made from 6 April 2008 until 5 April 2011, paying a Government supplement of 3p on every pound you give.

How you can make a difference

Our Light up a Life appeal is an opportunity to give a gift in memory of a loved one and support your local Hospice.

Your gift could mean so much to a patient at the Norfolk Hospice, Tapping House, or to someone who has lost a loved one. Some examples of the cost of delivering our services include:

- £25 to provide a one to one counselling session
- £50 to pay for a specialist palliative care nurse to carry out a home visit
- £100 to provide specialist equipment to aid mobility and independence
- £150 to provide therapeutic day care for one patient including complementary therapy, creative activities and lunch

Donations can be accompanied by the name of the person you wish to remember. This name will be inserted in our Light up a Life keepsake programme given to you at the service as a permanent memento.
