This voluntary role can be undertaken at a time convenient to the volunteer although it is essential that the volunteer has access to a digital camera and a computer with Internet access.

It is expected that the volunteer is able to collect a small quantity of items from one of our shops (located in King's Lynn, Downham Market or Snettisham), photograph and list the items on the Ebay website and finally package and send the item to the customer.

Full re-imburement of the postage paid will be made by the Hospice along with the supply of packing materials.
