We are looking for **Volunteer PAT Testers** who are able to regularly test small electrical appliances in our King's Lynn shop.

**This voluntary role is likely to take approximately one morning/afternoon session a fortnight at our King's Lynn shop. Whilst a qualified PAT tester would be preferred, full training will be provided to interested volunteers.**

All electrical items are collated at our King's Lynn shop although a flexible arrangement can be made if a volunteer would prefer to undertake the testing within their own premises/workshop.

A commitment to our vital care and support for people affected by life-limiting illnesses is essential.
