The event was organised by volunteer Hospice Therapists Sara Lee and Sheila Chapman to raise funds for a new therapy couch for the patients at The Norfolk Hospice, Tapping House. Zena Penty, Fundraising Co-ordinator said “It was a really enjoyable evening. Not only is Nick a very talented florist and keeping everyone mesmerised by his artistic demonstrations, he is also a very entertaining character, can talk as he works and was very amusing”. The evening had a seasonal theme offering a variety of gift stalls, entertainment by the Dersingham hand bell ringers, a luxury prize raffle and auction of the floral displays and signed T.V. memorabilia. Since 1984, the Hospice has been providing palliative care to people with cancer, neurological and other life-limiting conditions, to enable them to live life to the full for whatever time is left.

Our services include: holistic day care, home hospice support, bereavement support for families, regular carer support groups, transport, equipment loan and an information service.

We care for over 200 people a month at the hospice and at home. Our care is provided without charge throughout Norfolk and the Fens and it costs £1 million a year to run our Hospice. We serve a community stretching from Wisbech in the west to Dereham in the east and from Mundford in the south to Sheringham on the north Norfolk coast. We depend on the generosity of the community to survive: 85% our costs are paid for by the individuals, organisations and groups who give generously to support our vital care.

In life nothing is certain but, with your help, we can ensure that Norfolk and the Fens has the finest hospice care possible, now and in the future.
